First Church of Christ, Scientist, Baggot Street, Dublin



This church looks more like a bank so it will come as no surprise that the architects (Millar & Symes) were better known for building banks rather that churches. This pastiche built in 1927 was opened for service in 1928. It was demolished in 1974 (on a bank holiday weekend) and the Bord na Móna headquarters designed by Sam Stephenson were built in its place. 02 were tenants for a while but the Bord na Móna Annual report for 2015 mentions the continuing refurbishment of their investment property. The railings are still in place but not on the protected structures register.
